

Cevo II: Classroom & Maneuvers

As an ambulance operator, your squad, the patients you transport, and the general public relies on your ability to remain calm and focused while maneuvering safely through traffic. Without this ability, your crew would be unable to complete their duties, your patients would not receive the care they need, and the public safety would be in jeopardy.

Just as other medical professionals maintain and upgrade their skills, you, too, must keep your skills up to date. CEVO II has been designed specifically to help refresh and improve your driving skills in both emergency and non-emergency situations.

The class will consist of classroom time, as well as maneuvers and will take two days to complete.
